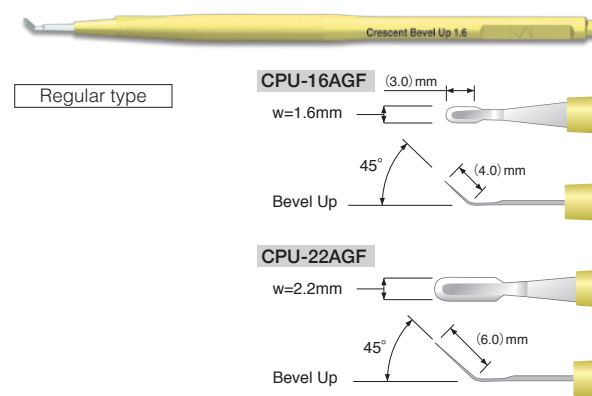
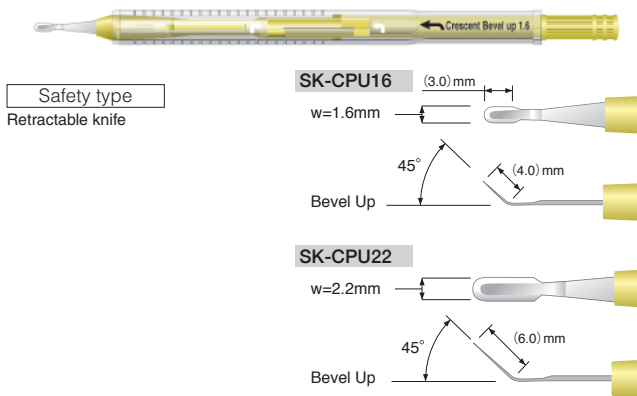
MICROSURGERY KNIVES for minimal incisions

- Regular types and safety types are available.

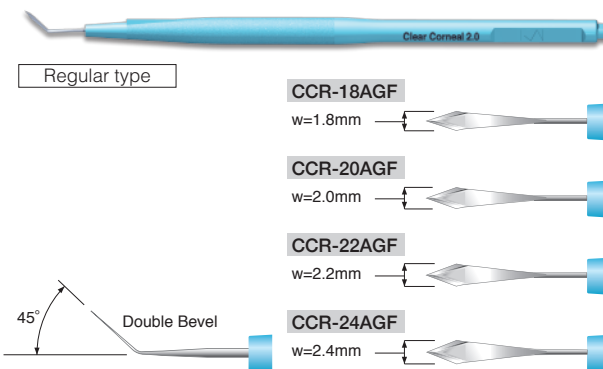
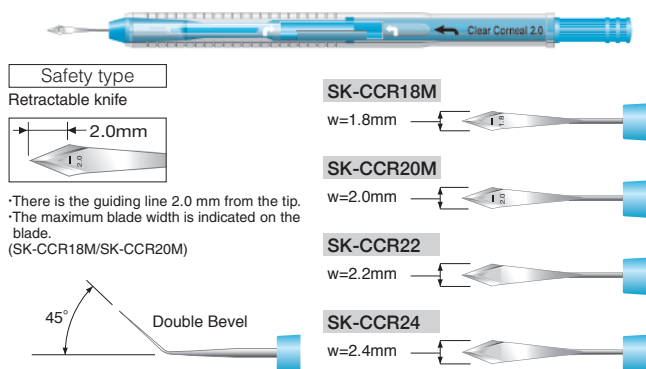

- Suitable for creating the optimal scleral tunnel flaps



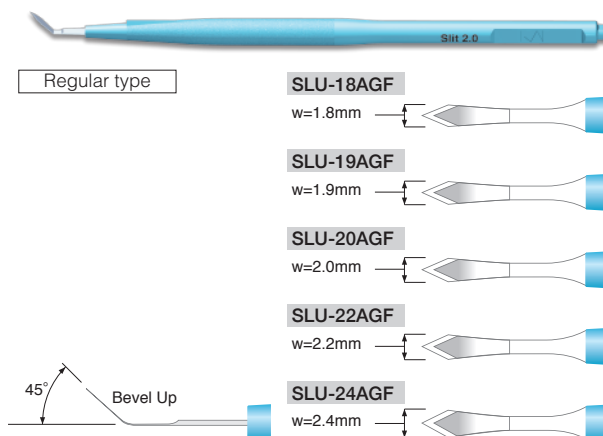
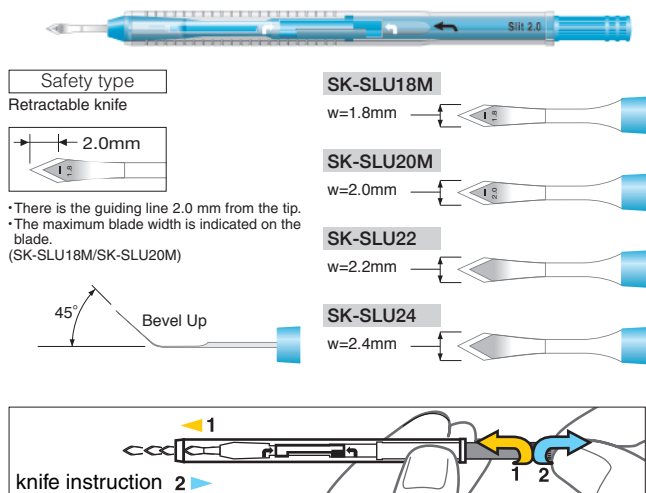
CLEAR CORNEAL KNIVES

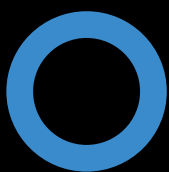
